Items for People in Need

St. Andrew's Ladies Auxiliary is a member, and Carla Kozak is our representative to the Edmonton Local Council of Women. **Requested are your donations** for people in need in hospitals, WIN (Women in Need) House, emergency shelters, etc. For a complete list see: www.elcw.ca/html/items_needed.html

Among the needs are new and/or gently used nightgowns, pj's, winter hats, scarves, mittens, quilts, blankets, lap blankets and shrugs for wheelchair users, sweat pants and tops.



Hygiene kit in a *Ziplock* bag: toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, brush, hand soap, plastic razor, lotion and washcloth. The Dollar Stores are a great source for purchasing bulk items in **travel size**.



Bags are needed to hold personal items. They can be closed with a zipper or drawstring, with handles or not. Used flight bags and backpacks in good condition are welcomed. The size should be about 12 to 14" x 18 to 24".

A project that youth may be interested in collecting are activity kits for children 3 years and older in emergency rooms and WIN House. In a container or cloth bag, place any combination of coloring books, crayons, stickers, gel pens, craft kits, activity books, small toys or puzzles.
